



In the mountains north of West Yellowstone, facets near the ground produced unstable results during stability tests. This layer was found on a NE facing slope around 9200 ft, but was not found on a SE facing slope nearby. Before committing to steep avalanche terrain, digging to the ground to assess the strength and distribution of this layer is a good idea. Photo GNFAC
